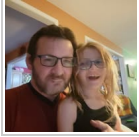

Until we meet again, keep sending us signs... and never, ever stop blowing those bubbles.

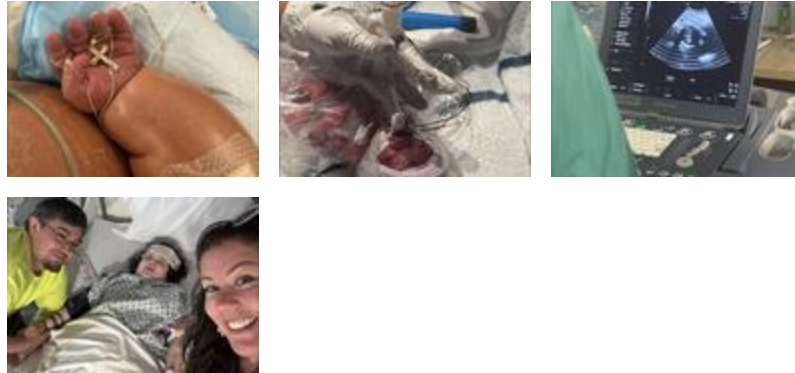
